

2025 TOWN BUDGET PUBLIC HEARING NOVEMBER 6, 2024

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the delinquent sewer and water bills, from the Town of Reading, as shown in the 2025 Reading Town Budget, be added to the January 2025 Town and County tax bills as a separate item for the arrears, as provided by Town Law Section 198 subsection (k).
